Host University: Chongqing University of Posts and Telecommunications (CQUPT)

Introduction to the program

Social Research & Chinese Language Study Program is open to all NAU students. Students do the social research, experience Chinese Cultural, and learn Chinese at CQUPT as a general visiting student. Upon completion of the program, students will receive a program certificate and an official transcript. This is an scholarship program, and the program fee and accommodation fee will be covered by CQUPT. Participants only need to pay their meals and return-flight tickets.

Why participate the program in CQUPT:

1. Experience China's university life

This is an exciting opportunity to be part of one of universities in China as visiting students and earn 4 credits in CQUPT. Participants will be arranged to stay in students dormitory.

2. Immersion with Chinese students

CQUPT has over 24000 students, all program participants will have Chinese buddies who help them to learn about Chinese culture and practice Chinese.

- Wide variety of Unique social research and Unique culture experience Students will have the opportunity to different places to do the social research and experience traditional Chinese culture.
- 4. Experience China's fourth municipality and one of the most popular tourism cities-Chongqing Chongqing is the logistic hub combining water, road and air transportation, a modern manufacturing base, an important business center and the pivot for integrated transportation and communications along the upper reaches of the Yangtze River and in the southwest China.

Courses: (4.00 total credits)

- 1. Intensive Chinese: Beginner or intermediate Chinese course assigned according to their language proficiency.
- 2. Modern China: A survey of Chinese history from the 1830s to the 1940s. Treatment of the political, socioeconomic, and cultural-intellectual developments in China. Emphasis will be given to the revolution and modernization.
- 3. Arts of China: Explores the foundations of Chinese civilization and the dimensions of Chinese culture.
- 4. Social Research: Visits to local enterprises, Chongqing and Chengdu to research and engage with the university community. Field trips specific to the subjects of study: Dazu Rock Carving, Ciqikou Ancient Town, Hongya Cave Local Culture Center, etc. All of these field trips complement classroom learning.

Fees:

- 1. Program Fee: waived
- 2. Accommodation fee: waived
- 3. Participants only need to pay their meals and return-flight tickets.

Accommodation:

Participants will be hosted in campus dormitory with double bedrooms with bedding; on-site management teams and oncall staff for emergencies if assistance is needed, and kitchen available.
