Applying for off-campus accommodation

There is a strong demand for rental properties in Darwin. This means there is usually a lot of competition for accommodation and the prices can be high. It is best to book short term accommodation for when you first arrive so you have a chance to view rental properties. Do not sign up for any accommodation without seeing it first and do not ask friends to get accommodation for you before you arrive. You may consider asking a friend to send you information and prices of accommodation prior to your arrival to give you more of an idea, but do not commit to a property on a friend's advice.

Accommodation up to 15 minutes travelling time (by car) to the University includes (but not limited to) the following suburbs: Wanguri, Tiwi, Casuarina, Brinkin, Nightcliff, Alawa, Anula, Coconut Grove, Nakara, Leanyer, Wagaman, Rapid Creek, Lyons and Jingili.

When applying for a house or unit through a real estate agency you will need rental references from properties you have rented in the past. Remember, real estate agents WILL call your referees. If you do not have rental references, personal references can be used, such as a reference from a previous employer.

Rent is to be kept in advance as set out in your Residential Tenancy Agreement (lease). You will be expected to pay a bond (normally 4 weeks rent) and to pay a minimum of 2 weeks rent in advance. Privately rented accommodation (not through an agency) can vary according to the landlord but bond cannot exceed the amount of 4 weeks rent.

If you need to break the lease you are responsible for and must pay the rent until the property is re-let to a suitable tenant or until the lease expires. It is advisable to read the Tenancy Agreement and understand all the conditions outlined.

The Accommodation Officer can assist you if you are having difficulty in understanding the Tenancy Agreement. Please be aware that all off-campus accommodation is privately owned and is not controlled by the University.

Short Term/Temporary Accommodation

We advise you to book short term accommodation (listed below) for when you first arrive in Darwin so that you have the opportunity to view and inspect properties you may wish to rent. Do not sign or send money without seeing the property first as differing expectations can be problematic.

Prices vary throughout the year in Darwin due to the high demand for accommodation in the 'Dry Season'
